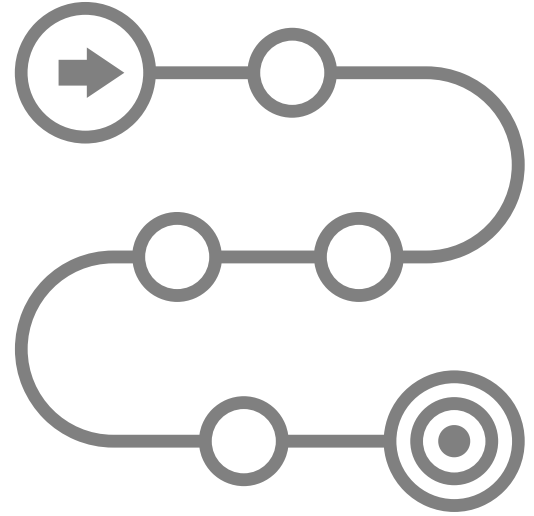

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# PCP Recruitment

We are announcing that our recruitment for Primary Care Physicians (PCPs) will be open from March 3, 2025, through April 30, 2025. Eligible providers must be included in PGIP and already be PCMH designated (for VBR). Providers that join during this period will be eligible for VBR starting September 1, 2025.

While there is currently no minimum requirement for the number of asthma and COPD patients to participate, please note that future stipulations around patient population size may be introduced.

Additionally, physicians with fewer than 10 attributed patients will not have visible data on the population health registry. Join us in advancing healthcare quality of care for asthma and COPD patients across Michigan. For more information on how to apply, please visit our [website](#). # User Guide: Accessing the Data Dashboard

The dashboard enables POs to follow patients attributed to their INHALE participating providers on quality, utilization, and medication measures. The All Measures Patient List download option on the Executive Summary page allows POs and practices to monitor patients who may benefit from follow-up or medication changes. The measure trend displays allow users to track their PO-level progress toward meeting their VBR performance goals.

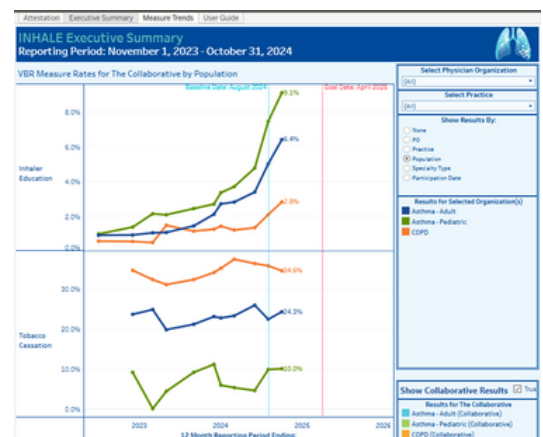
## Step 5: Navigate the Data Dashboard

- Use the filtering options to drill down into specific practices or individual providers.
- This action will adjust the data visualizations to reflect the selected practice/provider, providing more granular insights.
- Utilize filters and options available on the dashboard to view and interpret the data.

## Step 6: Log Out

- When you are finished using the dashboard, ensure you log out.
