PO Scorecard Legend

Measure	Description
Recruitment	Recruitment requirement thresholds are determined by BCBSM.
1	A PO Clinical Champion and Admin Liaison will be identified and designated within the INHALE Admin Portal within the specified period outlined in the scorecard. PO Clinical Champion needs to hold a medical professional license (MD, DO, PA, NP, RN, RT, PharmD). No non-licensed personnel may hold the clinical champion role.
2	A PO Administrative lead who will serve as the primary contact for INHALE must be designated in the Admin Portal and this information must be kept up to date.
3	Attend specified number of PO monthly calls hosted by INHALE. If a PO monthly call is not held/canceled, it will not count against attendance.
4	PO Clinical Champions are required to attend the annual INHALE CW meeting for at least 90% of the meeting duration.
5	PO Admin is required to attend the annual INHALE CW meeting for at least 90% of the meeting duration.
6	PO Clinical Champion or PO Admin logs into the INHALE Data Dashboard at least once quarterly during the measurement year, reviews their PO/Practice performance.
7	PO Clinical Champion or PO Admin will complete the PDSA form in the admin portal on an INHALE performance measure (OCS stewardship or Inhaler Education) by the end of the measurement year.
8 and 9	Performance measure will be scored at the aggregated PO level for all INHALE participating practices in a PO. The 5% increase or 5% relative decrease will be calculated from the start of the measurement period baseline calculation.
