Attestation Process

- INHALE is requiring POs to attest to the accuracy of the providers listed as participating in the INHALE Admin Portal
- Projected attestation periods:
 - After SCP recruitment (~October)
 - Prior to submission of SCP VBR (~January)
 - After PCP recruitment (April)
 - Prior to submission of PCP VBR (~June)
- PO's responsibility to add/remove providers
 - Additions will only be accepted during recruitment




