

2025 VBR FAQs

Do the VBR timeline changes impact the 2024 VBR reimbursement period, or just 2025 VBR reimbursement and beyond?

No. The VBR reimbursement period for 2024 (measurement period 2023) will not be affected by any of the changes to the VBR updates effective January 1, 2024.

Are the 2024 PCP and SCP VBR Requirement documents shared with participants in September 2023 still in effect?

N0. The updated VBR timeline and measurement period replaces the documents disseminated in September 2023.

Do providers need to meet both the 11 points and the 5% increase on the Inhaler Education measure to receive the reward in 2025?

Yes. As CQIs mature, the focus shifts from only accruing incentives from all participation to both participation and performance. In 2024, providers will need to participate and improve their Inhaler Education rates.

Is the Tobacco Cessation Counseling measure continuing in 2024?

Yes. The Tobacco Cessation Counseling measure will continue in 2024 and potentially beyondThis is a CQI portfolio-wide measure.

Is the Tobacco Cessation Counseling measure part of the 5% VBR for INHALE?

No. The Tobacco Cessation Counseling measure is not part of INHALE's 5% VBR. Meeting the measure is worth an additional 2%. This means that providers who meet the INHALE 5% VBR reward may also earn an additional 2% for tobacco cessation for a total of 107%.

If a provider does not meet the INHALE 5% reward, can they still earn the 2% VBR for participating in the Tobacco Cessation Counseling measure?

Yes. Providers who are unable to earn the INHALE 5% VBR, but meet the Tobacco Cessation Counseling target, will be awarded the 2% VBR.

Will activities completed in the Fall of 2023 count toward the 2024 VBR measurement period now that the timeline has shifted?

Yes. Activities like the Fall 2023 Regional meeting or onboarding activities prior to 1/1/2024 will be counted towards the 2024 measurement period.

Will the VBR reimbursement period be affected by the new timeline?

No. The reimbursement periods for both SCPs and PCPs will not be affected and will start on 3/1/2024 for SCPs and 9/1/2024 for PCPs.



If specialists met the Tobacco Cessation measure for 2023, do they still need to do the 5% improvement for 2024? The new timeline seems to shift things.

Yes. With the shift in the timeline, Specialists will essentially have 2 measurement years to try and meet the target- the chance to earn the VBR is doubled. INHALE will take the better of the 2 years when scoring.

The PCPs have several months overlap between the current measurement period (9.1.23-5.31.24) with the 2025 VBR measurement period (1.1.24 – 8.31.24). When they attend the Lung Learning Labs and Spring Regional meetings, will this count toward their 2024 and 2025 VBR?

Yes. If there is overlap between the measurement periods, credit will be given toward both VBR years.

Are POs still expected to meet the requirements that were distributed in September 2023?

Yes. POs are still expected to meet the Participation Requirements distributed in 9/2023 to be eligible to receive the Participation incentive.
