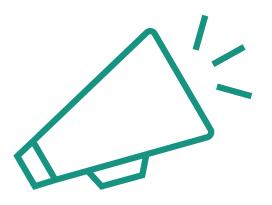

Primary Care Provider recruitment March 3rd - April 30th, 2025

These providers will be eligible for VBR starting September 1st.

Recruitment Reminders

- If a physician has less than 10 attributed patients, data will not be visible on the Data Dashboard.
- Provider eligibility requirements:
 - PCPs must be on PGIP Snapshot and PCMH designated (for VBR)
- INHALE does not/will not add people to the list of participating providers outside of recruitment windows.

PCP Recruitment Instructions –





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Step	Action	Responsible		
1.	Log into the INHALE Admin Portal	PO Admin		
2.	Navigate to the PO Level heading/ PCP Recruitment on the menu on the left	PO Admin		
3.	 Click PCP Recruitment This takes you to the INHALE PCP Recruitment 2025 page; A list of eligible practices will display 	PO Admin		
4.	Click on the appropriate practice, and locate the provider's name, click Nominate. INHALE PCP Recruitment 2025 Total Address No. Practice Liabson(s) N/A	PO Admin		
5.	Repeat Step 4 until you have nominated all the providers for recruitment during this cycle.	PO Admin		
6.	After nomination, INHALE will "approve" the nominations. NOTE: They will not display in the Admin Portal for tasks until September 1st.			
7.	PO will review list of providers nominated for recruitment and verify accuracy of list PO Admin			
8.	INHALE will review list of providers nominated for recruitment and verify accuracy of list INHALE CC			
NOTE: INHALE will ask POs to attest, as part of the verification process, 2-4 times a year that all providers (PCPs/SCPs) listed as participating in INHALE is accurate.

VBR and Performance Measure Tools for Success





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- Review all <u>VBR Information</u> relevant to your PO/Practices
 - Scorecards, timelines and potential schedule of VBR activity completion
- Review PDSA Worksheet documents
 - Printable worksheet, instructions, rubric, and example PDSA
- Review and download patient and provider resources from our <u>Toolkits</u> and <u>Resources</u> pages
- Log in to the <u>Data Dashboard</u> regularly
 - Encourage your practices to obtain accounts to check their performance progress
 - Review the <u>User Guide</u> for assistance with navigating the dashboard – the guide found in the dashboard is usually the most up to date
 - Review the <u>Access & Set Up Guide</u> for accessing the dashboard
- Check the <u>Admin Portal</u> for score updates and VBR progress tracking

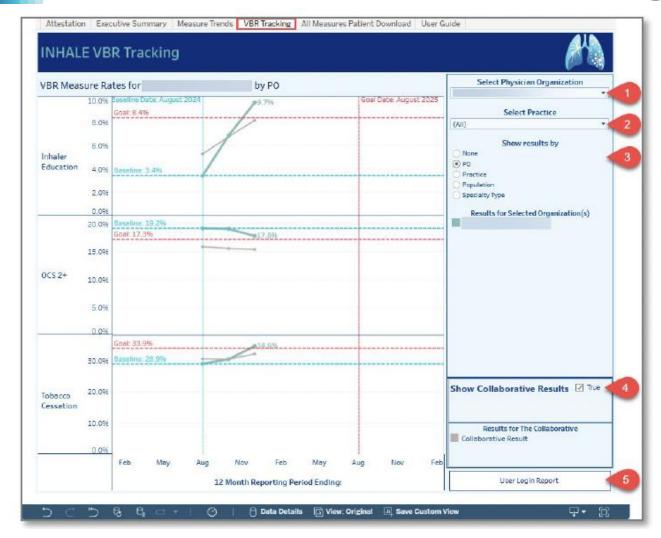




Data Dashboard VBR Tracking Tip







- Select Physician Organization. Select from the dropdown list.
- 2. Select Practice. Select from the dropdown list.
- Show Results By. Select one of the following radio buttons: None, PO, Practice, Population, Specialty Type, or Participation Date.
- 4. Show Collaborative Results. Click to check or uncheck the True checkbox.
- User Login Report button in the bottom right corner is visible only to PO users.
- 6. Click the button to view the user login stats for your organization.
- To download the report, click the download icon in the bottom right corner of the screen and select Download Crosstab, and PU User Stats, then Select Format (CSV or Excel), and click Download.
