\$35 a month caps on out-of-pocket costs on some inhalers

- Price caps apply to people with commercial/private insurance or no insurance
- At some pharmacies, the savings will be automatic.
- If your pharmacy does not participate in the automatic savings, you can use the savings cards (below) to get the discount

Eligibility

Patient Resources for Low-cost or Free Inhalers:

- Commercial Insurance or no insurance: You may be eligible for these offers if you are insured by commercial insurance and your insurance does not cover the full cost of your prescription OR have no insurance at all.
 - o Must have valid prescription
 - o Patients presenting savings card at participating pharmacies will pay as low as \$0-\$35 for each 30-day supply (1 inhaler)
 - Insurance types not eligible for participation:
 - Medicare Part D
 - Medicaid
 - Medigap
 - TriCare
 - CHIP
 - Veterans Affairs or Department of Defense benefits
 - Patients who are Medicare eligible and enrolled in an employer-sponsored group waiver health plan or government-subsidized prescription drug benefit program for retirees.
 - If you are enrolled in a state or federally funded prescription insurance program, you may not use this savings card even if you elect to be processed as an uninsured (cash-paying) patient.
 - o Restricted to residents of the US or a United States Territory (Puerto Rico, Guam, U.S. Virgin Islands, Northern Mariana Islands, American Samoa).
 - Medications with \$0-\$35 coupons (alphabetical order):
