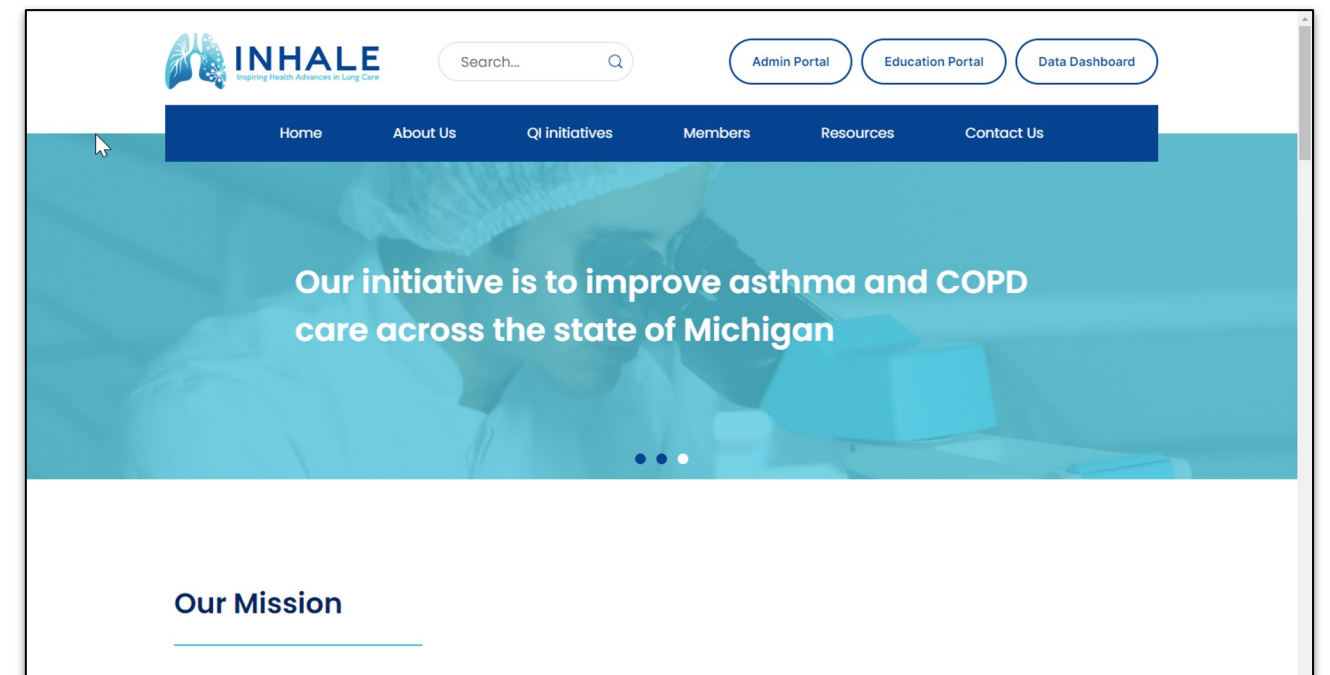


## Next PO Recruitment will open February
