

Step 1: For users who have forgotten their passwords, on the Login page, click the link to receive a password reset email.





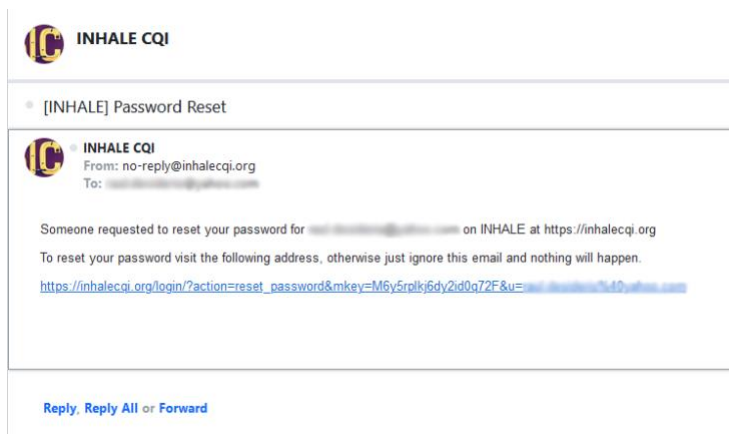

Step 6: Log back in using your email and newly created password. You will then have full access to the platform again.
