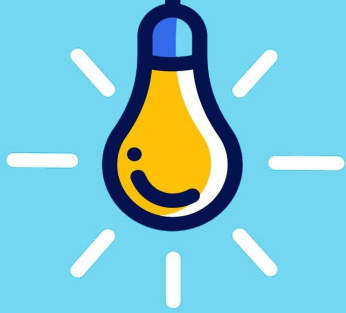


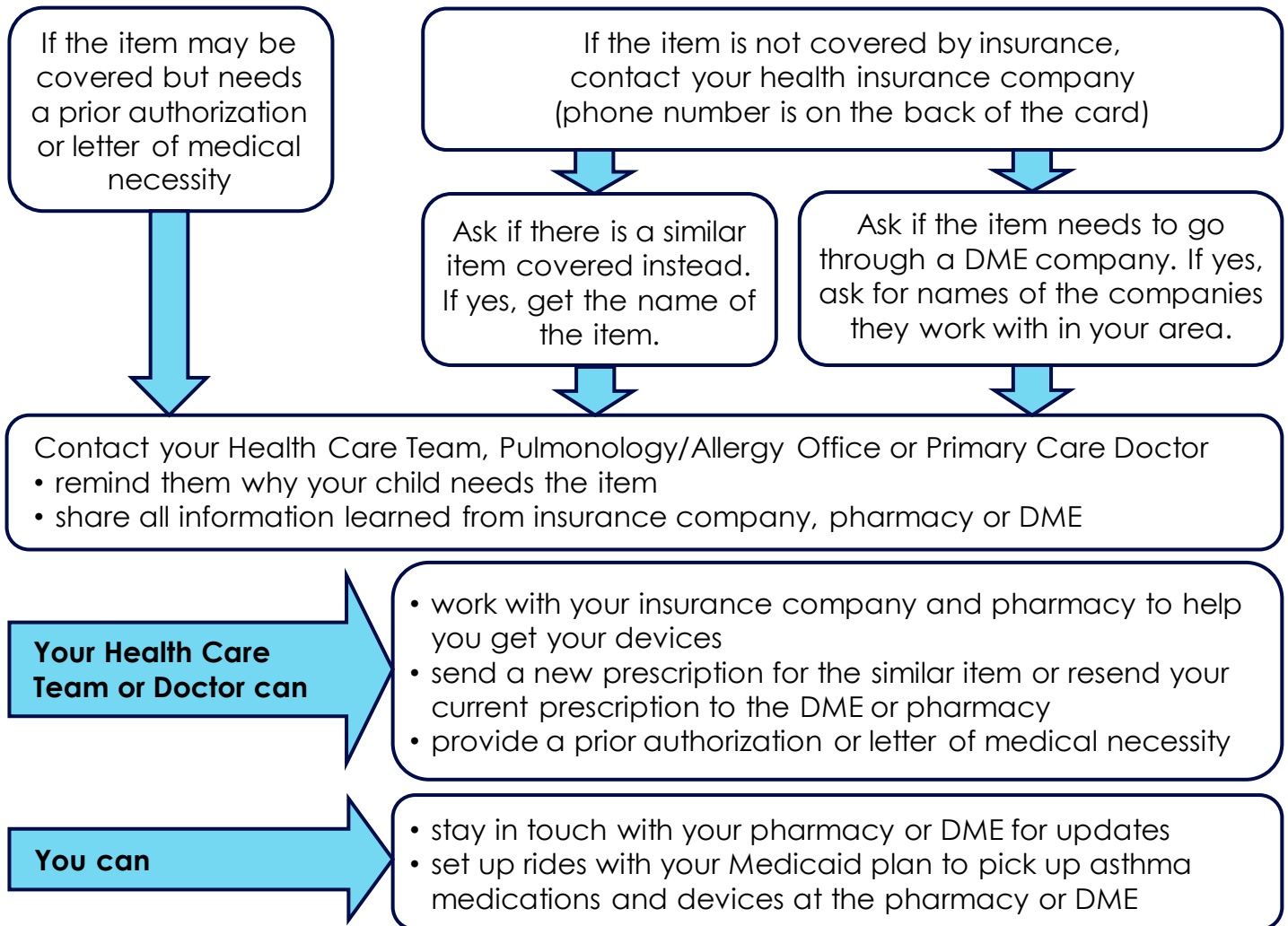
Tips for Getting Asthma Devices



Asthma devices, including spacers/valved-holding chambers, peak flow meters and nebulizer supplies require a prescription to be covered by insurance.

All Michigan Medicaid plans cover 4 spacers (valved-holding chambers) per year at the durable medical equipment (DME) company or pharmacy. No prior authorization is needed.

If a prescription was sent, but the pharmacy or DME is unable to fill it, ask what the problem is and what they think is needed to fix it.
